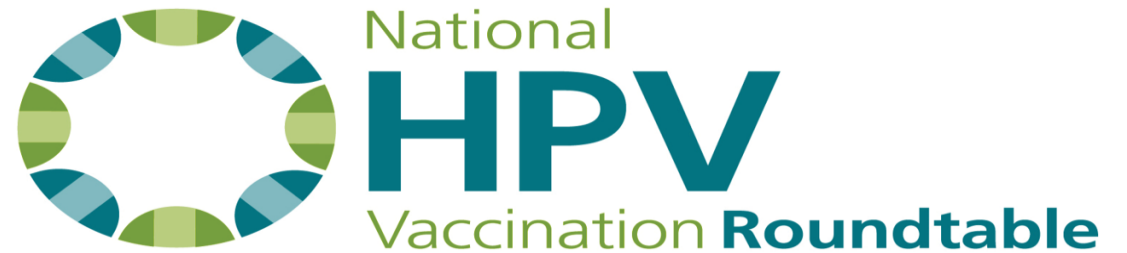

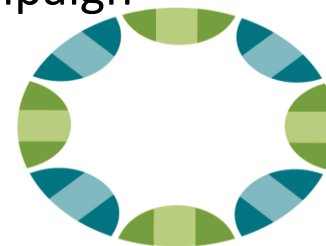

IPVS HPV Elimination Statement



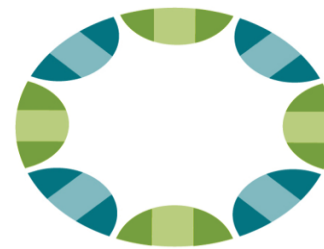

SE Regional Coalition Leadership Summit

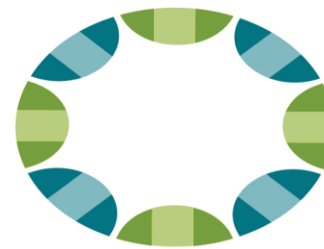
UPDATE:

- Provided an opp to apply for supplemental funding
- Proposed:
 - 2 day meeting
 - Up to 7 states
 - Includes 16 task group members
 - 4 reps/state plus 2 ACS staff
 - 2 RT evaluators
 - Provide funding to 7 states to host 1 day state meetings (up to 16 attendees)
 - Partner with UAB NCI Cancer Center to host meeting
 - Late 2018 or early 2019
