- Shauntay, CA CCCP: Steering Committee is planning CA Roundtable, using input from Texas. Meeting planned for October 2018.
- Kimberly, NAACHO: Completed an [immunization program assessment](#) with 517 local health departments. Findings include strengths and best practices, opps to leverage state/local resources. They will do deeper dive on next steps. Also submitted comments on NVAC report for HPV workgroup. Their comments and recs were incorporated into draft report.
- Trisha, NAOAHEC: [Upcoming webinar on School RNs](#)
- Bethany, AIM: Iowa continues to build out additional [videos](#). Kris Sharrington, a caretaker/survivor's spouse filmed a new video from a parent perspective as to the importance of physician role. Video is in final edits. In addition, a national immunization coalition met in Atlanta during the May NIC meeting. We had the opp to talk about the State TG work, and hear from states about the work they are doing...HPV was very prevalent topic. Lots of cancer center engagement.
- CCCNP: Upcoming state HPV team's being trained in Atlanta and Houston. Shauntay & Jane going to Houston in August; IA going to ATL in July.
- AFIX is rebranding—focus on state immunization providers, now a QI approach, prioritizing system level work.

III. Project Work & Discussion

- Bethany walked through 3 key project objectives (see slides)
- **Promotion of the [Online Guide](#):** The group reviewed and provided input on the Online Guide Sell Sheet, which we can provide to States at the CCCNP trainings (*POSTNOTE: Sheet was finalized in July and is now posted in our [Resource Library](#)*)
- **State Coalition Survey:** The group discussed undertaking a survey of state coalitions. Background: States have not been surveyed since fall of 2016 by Comp Cancer HPV/CRC survey. Much of our project work is based on input from the Midwest Listening Session, but that input is also now over a year old. Getting additional feedback on whether the needs for online collaboration are still the same is important before we continue to invest more time and more costly resources in developing online forums.

Discussion: Group members were asked the kinds of things they wanted to know from states:

- What are they working on

- Who are they collaborating with
- Who would they like to collaborate with to broaden their reach
- Who would they like to work with but have been unable to engage
- Have they engaged health plans or health systems? If so, how?
- Feedback/ranking on priority areas
- What has been successful
- Share innovative/original projects or partnerships
- Gauge interests and needs, challenges and areas for improvement

ACTION NEEDED:

- Members asked to email any addition input by July 6th
 - Staff will work with evaluator to flesh out survey questions
 - Bring back to larger group for wide swath of input
- **Southeastern Regional Gathering:** Roundtable has an opportunity to apply for supplemental funding to host an event similar to the Iowa Listening Session for southeastern U.S. states.
